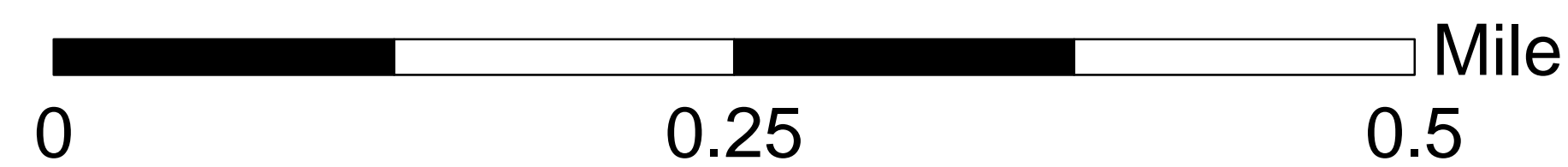
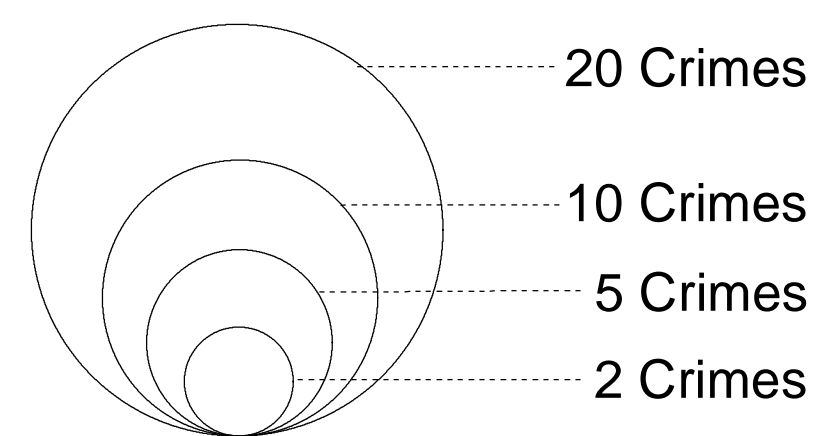


University of Utah Campus Crime
